

CANOE ISLAND FRENCH CAMP RECOMMENDED CLOTHING AND EQUIPMENT LIST

- ❖ **LAYERING** is the key to a camp wardrobe in the San Juan Islands. It tends to be cool in the morning and evening, warm during the day. Combinations of shorts, long pants, t-shirts, sweatshirts or fleece pullovers, hats and rain gear are ideal.
- ❖ **RAIN** Although the San Juan Islands get only 16" - 26" of rain year, be prepared for it.
- ❖ **LUGGAGE** should be address-tagged, compact and easy to carry on the ferry by each person. A rolling suitcase, rolling duffel bag or backpack are easiest. A wooden clothes box is provided at the camp.
