

## Medical Forms and Your Child's Medicine

The Charlemagne school nurse will administer medical forms before the end of the school year, and will work with you to coordinate the medications your child will need at camp.

Until that time, please keep the following in mind, with regard to the enclosed medical history form, and your child's medicines for camp.

- The 4J district will only allow us to dispense **Benadryl** and **Tylenol** at camp. All other medications must be provided by families for their child.
- Do NOT list or pack for your child any non-essential medications such as multivitamins or fluoride.
- For packing, plan to provide the **original box** and **prescriptions with original label** for each medication, and be sure they have not expired.
- Each child's meds should be sent in a large Ziploc bag with child's name and DOB on it in sharpie.
- On the Dietary Needs Form, please list food allergies vs. dietary restrictions clearly.
- We have not had, nor do we expect any serious medical emergencies at camp. However, be assured that there are two EMT trained staff on site at camp throughout the week.
